

Covid-19 Safety Protocol

We are pleased to have you visit the beautiful Similkameen Valley. The health of our visitors and staff is our utmost priority. We have taken measures to ensure their well-being. We have implemented health and safety precautions in accordance with the Provincial Health Officer and WorkSafeBC guidelines.

We ask that visitors enter the wineshop or attend outdoor tastings only if they are feeling well and are not showing any symptoms of Covid-19, have not travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days, and have not had contact with any persons who may have had contact with Covid-19.

We have strict guidelines for staff to stay home if feeling unwell.

We have implemented an online reservation system for tastings. Staff will determine whether or not we are able to accept walk-ins. All walk-in customers who are tasting must complete our contact tracing form.

Please respect social distancing protocols of 2 metres and wait for staff direction.

Sanitizers are available at entrance points and we request that all visitors sanitize their hands prior to entering the wineshop and attending tastings.

Tastings will take place outdoors. 6 or fewer guests in one group. Winery staff will wear masks during tasting. Individual spittoons will be supplied for each guest.

Anyone inside the wineshop must be masked.

All counters and frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized between customers. We use a commercial grade dishwasher for sanitizing all glassware.

Our wineshop capacity is reduced to a maximum of 8 people, including staff.

We are happy to have you visit. One of the things we love most about wine is how it brings people together to share and enjoy. We hope to continue to do this in a comfortable and safe manner.
