The grapes for this wine were grown in the Ancient Lakes AVA just three and a half our drive south of the winery. The picturesque vineyard overlooks the majestic Columbia Gorge. Set high above the Columbia River, the AVA is known for its cooler sites and white grapes dominate the region. This is rare in Washington and something we sought when looking to source grapes to make some white wine.

This 100% Roussanne wine features big concentrated and complex aromas and flavours, a medium bodied mouthfeel with a long finish. Flowers and herbs jump from the glass. It is bright with notes of meyer lemon, thyme, beeswax and pears. Pour with west coast seafood, sunshine and friends.
